Please consider this a request to the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) for information pursuant to California's Public Records Act, Government Code sections 6250 *et seq.* I would like to examine for possible copying the following documents:

1. Any and all documents including, but not limited to, correspondence, phone logs, phone conversation notes, files, memos, meeting notes, photographs, minutes, agenda, electronic records, computer records, files or associated communications regarding definition of and boundaries of the described zones in the paper entitled "Efficacy of aerial mosquito adulticiding in reducing human cases of West Nile virus in Sacramento County, California, 2005."
2. Any and all documents including, but not limited to, correspondence, phone logs, phone conversation notes, files, memos, meeting notes, photographs, minutes, agenda, electronic records, computer records, files or associated communications regarding data tables (including patient id, physician stipulated onset date and reporting date, and zone in which residence is located) used in preparing the paper entitled "Efficacy of aerial mosquito adulticiding in reducing human cases of West Nile virus in Sacramento County, California, 2005."
3. Any and all documents including, but not limited to, correspondence, phone logs, phone conversation notes, files, memos, meeting notes, photographs, minutes, agenda, electronic records, computer records, files or associated communications regarding mosquito abundance and mosquito infection data used in preparing the paper entitled "Efficacy of aerial mosquito adulticiding in reducing human cases of West Nile virus in Sacramento County, California, 2005."
4. Any and all documents including, but not limited to, correspondence, phone logs, phone conversation notes, files, memos, meeting notes, photographs, minutes, agenda, electronic records, computer records, files or associated


communications regarding bird abundance and bird infection data used in preparing the paper entitled "Efficacy of aerial mosquito adulticiding in reducing human cases of West Nile virus in Sacramento County, California, 2005."

Any and all documents including, but not limited to, correspondence, phone logs, phone conversation notes, files, memos, meeting notes, photographs, minutes, agenda, electronic records, computer records, files or associated communications regarding the paper "Efficacy of aerial mosquito adulticiding in reducing human cases of West Nile virus in Sacramento County, California, 2005" with Ryan Carney, who is listed as a co-author of the paper and employee of CDPH but who you claim no longer works for CDPH.

Should you decide that any of the requested material is not to be disclosed, pursuant to Government Code, section 6255, please describe the material withheld and specify in detail the statutory or administrative basis for withholding the requested material. (See Government Code, §§6253 and 6255.) These sections state that any documents requested that are being withheld must be stated so in writing when a written request has been made.
