Dear Sir or Madam:

Please consider this a request to the California Department of Health Services (CDHS) for information pursuant to California's Public Records Act, Government Code sections 6250 *et seq.* I would like to examine for possible copying the following documents:

1. Any and all documents including, but not limited to, correspondence, phone logs, phone conversation notes, files, memos, meeting notes, photographs, minutes, agenda, electronic records, computer records, files or associated communications regarding any risk/benefit analyses that you have performed, had performed, or have used in making decisions and/or recommendations about the spraying of aduenticides in Sacramento and/or Yolo County.
2. Copies of any risk/benefit analyses you performed, had performed, or relied upon in making decisions about the aerial spraying of the Sacramento area in 2005 and/or 2007 and/or Yolo County in 2006, together with any reports or notes of discussions regarding risk/benefit analyses utilized in formulating the aerial spray policy for Sacramento and/or Yolo County.
3. A copy of the paper Vicki Kramer showed to Councilmember Fong in the meeting in his office on the morning of July 27, 2007, as proof that the aerial spraying of Sacramento in 2005 was successful, including any correspondence regarding submission of the paper or any previous versions for publication in any journal.

Should you decide that any of the requested material is not to be disclosed, pursuant to Government Code, section 6255, please describe the material withheld and specify in detail the statutory or administrative basis for withholding the requested material. (See Government Code, §§6253 and 6255.) These sections state that any documents requested that are being withheld must be stated so in writing when a written request has been made.
