Email report:

I went to the Davis cemetery on Sunday morning July 16th. I only canvassed a small area because I found a lot of vases containing water that had been there for a while because the flowers were dead. There were some containers with jell but not all of them. I think there should be signs up or something because it is not obvious that there's jell available. (if there is jell available).

Also I don't know about the area where the cattails are. There could be some water there. (there used to be a stream running through there) Now the brush and berry bushes are too thick to inspect if there is actually water standing around.

Chestnut Park- I didn't find any standing water in the whole park except there was a low area on the tennis court and there was water there, probably from the sprinkler. If the sprinklers go on everyday it's possible that the water never gets to dry up and could be a potential problem.

Lastly, I got my door hanger delivered quite a while ago and I think there should be a more vigorous campaign if the mosquito problem is still a threat. I would like to see door hangers go on all the doors of the residents of Davis again. I'm willing to do a precinct or two in my area.
